Do you have grand-kin, children, nieces, nephews or neighbours who would be interested? ... or for whom you could provide a ride?

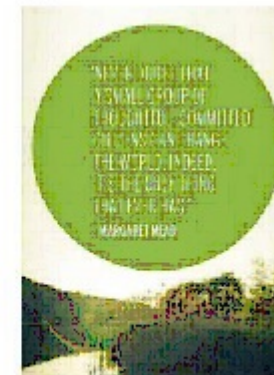

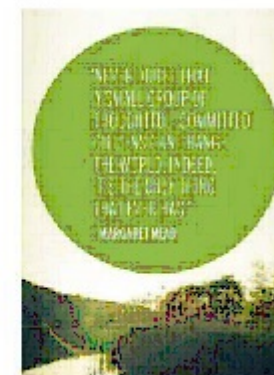

The Smiths Falls District Collegiate Institute (SFDCI) and the students of the Indigenous Studies Program and local Indigenous youth are hosting the second annual powwow on Turtle Island in the Town of Smiths Falls today. The purpose of the powwow is to bring people together; to connect the school with the community; and to share, teach and celebrate Indigenous culture and traditions.

SFDCI is within the Upper Canada District School Board spanning the Traditional Territories of the Algonquin and the Mohawk Nations. Akwesasne Mohawks as well as the Algonquins of Pikwàkanagàn First Nation will be conducting the powwow.

Today's powwow will feature the grand entrance at 12 pm and closing ceremony at 5 pm.

The powwow will feature traditional song, dance and drumming as well as traditional craft and food vendors, art installations and educational exhibits prepared by SFDCI Indigenous Studies students. First Nations educational institutions, and an exhibit of First Nations artifacts found along the Rideau waterway will be featured on-site.
