Snapshot as of June 2016



Date	Activity
MARCH 2016	Transition Team advised the congregation that they would be recommending to Church Council that the Period of Interim Ministry be extended to June 30, 2017. At May 29, 2016 meeting, Church Council approved the request.
APRIL 2016	Transition Team continued to implement the transition plan, by engaging the congregation's participation in the six month review (on-line survey or hard copy) of the Interim Ministry and providing support to the Rev. Arlyce in her work.
MAY 2016	Transition Team continued to implement plan, focussed on analyzing the survey results and passing the issues raised to appropriate leadership teams for discernment and action.
JUNE 2016	Transition Team completes & submits to Four Rivers Presbytery the Covenant for Appointment Application to extend Trinity's Period of Interim Ministry to June 30, 2017. Transition Team presents to Council and the congregation reports on the activities conducted to date by the Transition Team and to report on the effectiveness of the Interim Ministry Period after six (6) months into the process. Transition Team continues to implement transition plan, by engaging the congregation in the process of self-discovery, discernment and decisions.
