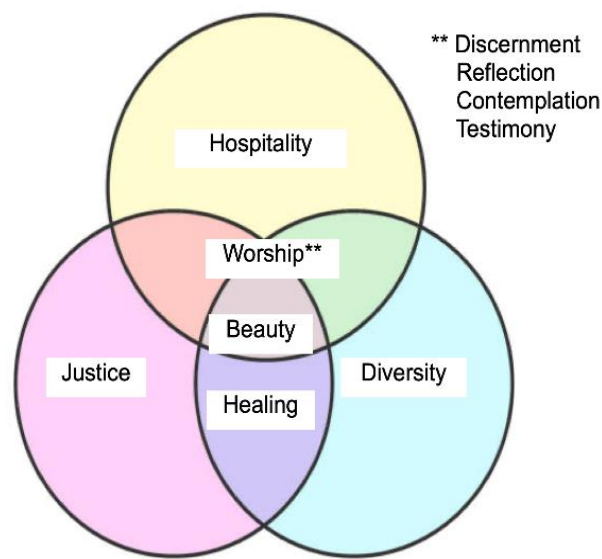

Reflection

A native of the west coast, Rob Rainer has lived extensively in British Columbia, New Brunswick, and the National Capital Region. Since October 2015, he and his wife, Mary Lou Carroll, have made their home in Tay Valley Township. In October 2018 Rob was elected to serve as a municipal ward councillor, and in October 2022 he was elected as Reeve. In that latter capacity Rob also is a member of Lanark County Council. Prior to entering politics, Rob was the executive director of several not-for-profit organizations, ranging from the community-based to the national. This included nearly six years serving a national charity, Canada Without Poverty. Through that work, Rob was deeply exposed to the systemic causes of poverty and inequality, and to the arguments for and against basic income. Rob's efforts to combat poverty in Canada were recognized in 2012 with the Queen Elizabeth II Diamond Jubilee Medal, presented to him by then Senator and long-standing basic income champion, Hugh Segal.

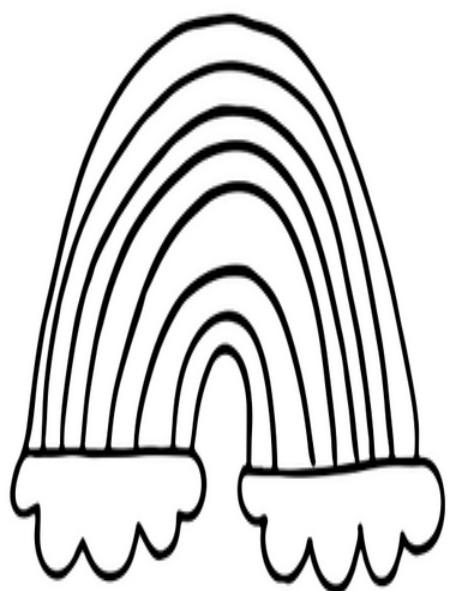

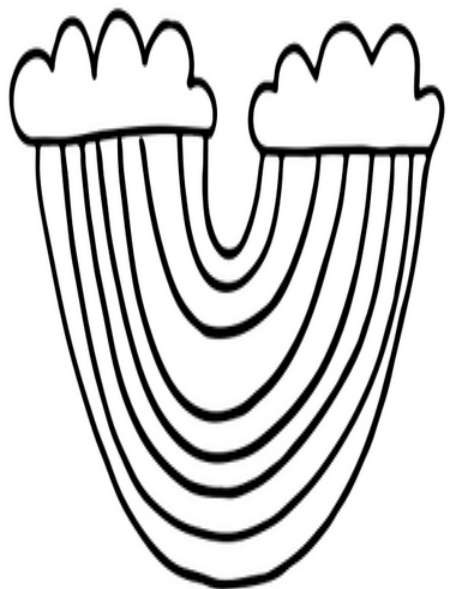
